We are proud of our accomplishments and appreciative of the continued support from our community – we truly would not be where we are today without you. Thank you for being part of our story.

In fiscal 2017/18, HomeSpace:

- celebrated the opening of two buildings, The Prelude in Radisson Heights (23 units) and Murray's House in South Calgary (23 units)
- obtained development permits for two new permanent supported apartment buildings, The Maple in Renfrew (26 units) and The Clayton in Bowness (30 units)
- collaborated with a new agency partner, the SHARP Foundation, to support the residents in Murray's House - bringing the number of agencies we partner with to 16
- received \$1.7 million from the Government of Alberta for the construction of up to 65 permanent supported housing units in two new developments that are in approvals
- secured three parcels of land from The City of Calgary following a competitive application process – developed plans to construct up to 135 new units of housing in three new buildings
- · expanded our property operations team by three new staff members
- hosted anniversary dinners for 600+ residents, agency partners and staff
